



From the Mountain Section:

To Bean Shoals Access (Surry County): 10 mi. From U.S. 52, take the Pinnacle exit and follow the signs to Horne Creek Farm Living Historical Farm. The park entrance is 0.7 mile past Horne Creek Farm Living Historical Farm.

To Ivy Bluff Access (Yadkin County): 20 mi. Take N.C. 67 to the town of East Bend. From Main St., turn right onto Fairground Rd. Turn right on Shady Grove Church Rd. Turn right on Shoals Rd. and follow to the park.

The portion of the Mountains-to-Sea Trail that runs through the park starts at the southern end of the Corridor Trail and travels to the Mountain Trail, past the family campground on the Grindstone Trail, and heads east out of the park on the Sauratown Trail below the park office. Follow the white circle blazes.
