Vineyards and trails go hand-in-hand in Surry County. Hikers, bikers, paddlers and anglers enjoy hundreds of miles of trails in the heart of the Yadkin Valley. Our undisturbed landscape includes mountain peaks, rolling foothills, old-growth forests and free-flowing rivers.

Paddling Trails

Surry County is home to four rivers offering 100 miles of navigable waters. The Yadkin River Blueway Trail is the best known waterway, but great paddling is also available on the Fisher, Mitchell and Ararat rivers. Developed access points, available throughout the county, can be found on the Surry County Four Rivers Map online at: YadkinValleyNC.com/map.

Cycling Trails

The Surry Scenic Bikeway is a system of road cycling routes covering 500 miles. There are four loops: Dobson-Elkin Loop, Lowgap-Mount Airy Loop, Mount Airy-Westfield Loop and the Mount Airy-Pilot Mountain Loop. There is also a spur off the Mount Airy-Pilot Mountain Loop that enters Pilot Mountain State Park and climbs 1,400 feet to the parking area below the summit.

Hiking & Biking Trails

From easy walking paths at Fisher River Park and the Granite City Greenway to strenuous uphill climbs at Pilot Mountain State Park, there are options for hikers of every skill level. Elkin has become a "trails town" thanks to miles of hiking and mountain biking trails built by the Elkin Valley Trails Association (ElkinValleyTrails.org). Mountain biking is also an attraction at Fisher River Park in Dobson and Westwood Park in Mount Airy. An interactive hiking and biking map is available at: YadkinValleyNC.com/map.

Trout Fishing Trails


The county's rivers provide 36 miles of trout waters. Designated sections of the Mitchell, Fisher and Ararat rivers are stocked twice a year with brown, rainbow and brook trout. These cold water streams have headwaters in the high elevation peaks along the Blue Ridge Parkway.
